**Fall Enrollment Trends: Fall 2003-2007
October 2007**

The attached tables provide student enrollment for the past five fall terms at the Community College of Baltimore County. In addition to providing enrollment for CCBC data are reported individually for the Catonsville, Dundalk, and Essex locations.

The last table provides enrollment information for students who are “New to CCBC” in Fall 2007. These students have not enrolled in credit or CEED courses at CCBC prior to Fall 2007, however the student may have previously taken courses at another institution.

CCBC Highlights:

- A total of 19,426 students enrolled in credit courses in Fall 2007
- Enrollment remained flat from the previous fall (less than 1% change)
- Part-time students increased by 1%; full-time students decreased by 3%
- First-time student enrollment (those who have no previous college credit) increased 11% in Fall 2007
- First-time students account for 19% of the total credit population in Fall 2007
- The number of African-American and Hispanic students enrolling in Fall 2007 increased (1% and 7% respectively); all other ethnic categories experienced a decrease
- In-county enrollment increased in Fall 2007 (1%)
- Essex experienced an increase in enrollment in Fall 2007 (2%); enrollment at Catonsville and Dundalk decreased

Catonsville Highlights:

- 9,094 students enrolled at Catonsville in Fall 2007
- The number of part-time students remained unchanged from previous year; full-time enrollment decreased by 3%
- The number of females enrolling at Catonsville slightly decreased
- The number of students in the 60 and over category increased 9% (a gain of 33 students); the number of students 20-29 years old decreased by 3%

Dundalk Highlights:

- 3,268 students enrolled in courses at the Dundalk Campus in Fall 2007
- Part-time enrollment decreased by 1%; full-time enrollment decreased by 10%
- The number of African-American, Hispanic, and Native American students increased in Fall 2007
- Most age groups experienced a decrease in Fall 2007

Essex Highlights:

- 9,580 students enrolled in courses at the Essex Campus in Fall 2007; 2% increase from previous fall
- The number of both male and female students increased
- The number of African-American, Asian, and Hispanic students increased in Fall 2007

- Most age categories experienced an increase in enrollment, however the number of students 30-39 years old decreased by 4%

New to CCBC Student Enrollment

- 4,979 new students enrolled at CCBC in Fall 2007 courses
- New to CCBC Students accounted for 26% of the total Fall 2007 enrollment
- The number of new students enrolled increased by 1% from previous Fall term
- Number of new female students increased by 3%; number of new male students remained flat from Fall 2006
- Increase number of new students in all ethnic categories with the exception of new Asian students (-11%)
- 5% increase in the number of students ages 15-19 and 3% increase in the number of new students from Baltimore County
