### **Spring Enrollment Trends: Spring 2003-2007 March 2007**

The attached tables provide student enrollment for the past five Spring terms at The Community College of Baltimore County. In addition to providing enrollment for CCBC data are reported individually for the Catonsville, Dundalk, and Essex locations.

The last table provides enrollment information for students who are “New to CCBC” in Spring 2007. These students have not enrolled in credit or CEED courses at CCBC prior to Spring 2007, however the student may have previously taken courses at another institution.

#### **CCBC Highlights:**

- A total of 17,970 students enrolled in credit courses in Spring 2007
- Enrollment decreased by 2% from Spring 2006 to Spring 2007 (a loss of 391 students)
- Both full-time and part-time enrollment decreased in Spring 2007, however part-time enrollment decreased at a greater rate (-1% full-time, -3% part-time)
- First-time student enrollment (those who have no previous college credit) decreased by 15% from Spring 2006 to 2007; first-time students account for 6% of total enrollment in Spring 2007
- The number of Hispanic and White students decreased (-8% and -5% respectively) while other minority student populations increased or remained unchanged
- In-county and out-of-county student enrollment decreased in Spring 2007 (-2% each); however enrollment for out-of-state students increased slightly (a gain of 10 students)
- Student enrollment decreased at relatively the same rate at the Catonsville, Dundalk, and Essex locations over the past year

#### **Catonsville Highlights:**

- 8,573 students enrolled in Catonsville courses in Spring 2007
- Students enrolled part-time in Catonsville courses decreased by 3% in Spring 2007, however the number of students enrolled full-time remained unchanged
- Catonsville experienced a decrease in the number of students in all but one age group

#### **Dundalk Highlights:**

- 3,088 students enrolled in courses at the Dundalk Campus in Spring 2007
- Full-time enrollment decreased by 16% in Spring 2007 while part-time enrollment in Dundalk courses decreased by 2%
- Dundalk experienced only a small decrease in the number of first-time students

#### **Essex Highlights:**

- 8,791 students enrolled in courses at the Essex Campus in Spring 2007
- Enrollment of full-time students increased by 3%
- Part-time enrollments decreased by 281 students over the past year (-4%)

- First-time enrollment decreased by 11% at Essex in Spring 2007 (a loss of 54 students)

**New to CCBC Student Enrollment**

- New student enrollment (those who have never enrolled in a credit or CEED course at CCBC prior to Spring 07) decreased by 1%
- New students accounted for 12% of the total Spring enrollment in both Spring 2006 and Spring 2007
