Summer Enrollment Trends: Summer 2003-2007 October 2007

The attached tables provide student enrollment for the past five summer terms at the Community College of Baltimore County. In addition to providing enrollment for CCBC data are reported individually for the Catonsville, Dundalk, and Essex locations.

The last table provides enrollment information for students who are “New to CCBC” in Summer 2007. These students have not enrolled in credit or CEED courses at CCBC prior to Summer 2007, however the student may have previously taken courses at another institution.

CCBC Highlights:

- A total of 6,366 students enrolled in credit courses in Summer 2007
- Enrollment decreased by 6% from Summer 2006 to Summer 2007 (a loss of 381 students)
- Part-time students decreased by 6%; full-time students increased by 4%
- First-time student enrollment (those who have no previous college credit) decreased by 46% from Summer 2006 to 2007; first-time students account for 6% of total enrollment in Summer 2007
- The number of Hispanic students enrolling in Summer 2007 increased 8% (a gain of 11 students); all other ethnic categories experienced a decrease
- In-county and out-of-county student enrollment decreased in Summer 2007; however enrollment for out-of-state students increased 10% (a gain of 4 students)
- Student enrollment in Summer 2007 decreased at Catonsville, Dundalk, and Essex locations over the past year

Catonsville Highlights:

- 3,396 students enrolled at Catonsville in Summer 2007
- The number of full-time and part-time students enrolled at Catonsville decreased in Summer 2007 (23% and 2% respectively)
- The number of males enrolling at Catonsville decreased by 10% while the number of females increased by 2%
- The number of students in the age groups of 30-39 and 40-59 enrolled at Catonsville increased from the previous summer (10% and 2% respectively)

Dundalk Highlights:

- 1,113 students enrolled in courses at the Dundalk Campus in Summer 2007
- Full-time enrollment decreased by 13% in Spring 2007 while part-time enrollment in Dundalk courses decreased by 4%
- The number of African-American students increased by 4%
- The number of students between the ages of 20-29 increased by 7%

Essex Highlights:

- 2,247 students enrolled in courses at the Essex Campus in Summer 2007
- Enrollment of full-time students increased by 50%; part-time enrollment decreased by 256 students over the past year (-4%)
- Hispanic students increased 29% (a gain of 12 students); all other ethnic categories experienced a decrease
- Notable enrollment decreases in all age categories in Summer 2007

New to CCBC Student Enrollment

- 1,072 new students enrolled at CCBC in Summer 2007 courses
- New students accounted for 17% of the total Summer 2007 enrollment
- New student enrollment decreased by 15% from the previous summer
- A decrease occurred in most demographic categories
